

# The Lego® Club

By using a child's love of playing with Lego®, children (ages 6-10) work on developing their turn-taking, sharing, listening, conversation, teamwork, shared attention and problem-solving skills to work with each other to help complete a task.

## What's involved in each session?

Participants are divided into teams to complete a set project. Each team is structured with group member roles to determine responsibilities. Group members are encouraged to work together using positive interactions to complete the team project.

## What is the cost?

The Lego® Club includes 8 one hour weekly group therapy sessions plus pre and post program preparation, feedback and support. (12 hrs total) 1:1 intake, assessment and reporting with facilitating therapist, including an NDIS Therapy Report (3 hrs total) Charged at the NDIS recommended Group Therapy and 1:1 Therapy rates: (NDIS recommended rate is subject to change).
